Students who Require a Visa to Study in the UK for Less than 6 Months

(Student Visitor Visa - CVV) Visa – SVV, or Child Visitor Visa

You will need an SVV if you are a citizen of one of the 'visa countries' listed by the UK Border Agency (UKBA) [here](#) and are 18 years of age or over. If your country is not on the UKBA list, it may still be advisable to apply for an SVV. If you are under 18 years old and a citizen of one of the 'visa countries', you will need to apply for a CVV. Citizens of the EEA (European Economic Area) do not require UK visas. **Finances.** You will need to prove to the UKBA on your visa application that you have sufficient funds to live and study while you are in the UK. You will need to demonstrate that you have sufficient funds to pay your tuition fees, accommodation and living expenses.

Sponsor. You must book your course with an approved education provider, such as EJO obtain your visa. The EJO UKBA Sponsor Licence Number is KJRT559J4 and EJO features on the UKBA list as a registered education provider. The full list of approved education providers is published by the UKBA at www.ukba.homeoffice.gov.uk. EJO would therefore be your 'Sponsor'.

Visa Letter. EJO will provide a visa letter once you have completed an enrolment form, paid a deposit for your course, and provided the necessary information and documents. However, for EJO to provide you with a Confirmation of Enrolment letter, we will require the following information and copies of all documentation:

- * Your full name (as it appears on your passport).
- * Your home address (full postal address).
- * Your date of birth.
- * Your place of birth.
- * Your nationality. be
- * Your passport number
- * A copy of your Passport
- * Confirmation of the type of visa SVV or CVV that you are applying for.

Application. You can download the official visa application form to apply for an **SVV** from the UKBA website at [Application form VAF1D - Student Visitor](#). The application for to use for a CVV application is at [Application form VAF1A - General Visitor](#) but please note the following UKBA advice:

If a child visitor is travelling to the UK without an adult (someone over the age of 18) you will need to provide:

- consent for your child to travel to the UK;
- evidence to show that suitable living arrangements have been made for their stay in the UK, and
- contact details of the parent or guardian in the child's home country.

If an adult is named as accompanying the child visitor on the visa, then the child must travel with that person; however, if the child visitor is likely to be travelling with another adult it may be better to apply for an "unaccompanied child visitor" visa. Up to two adults can be identified, as long as the parent or guardian has

given their consent (permission). If two adults are named on the child visitor's visa the child must travel with at least one of the named adults.

When applying for your UK visa you will require:

- * Your biometric details
- * A recent passport photo (45mm x 35 mm) in colour on a white background, not framed, on normal photographic paper, full face without hat or sunglasses.
- * Proof from your bank that you have sufficient funds to cover your tuition fees,

Should you be under 18 years of age and be applying for a Child Visitor Visa (CVV) you must provide a letter from your parents saying that they agree to you travelling and living independently. This must be written in your own language. If you do not provide the correct documentation you will probably not be successful in obtaining a visa.

Visa Fee. The SVV or CVV currently costs £70.00. You will not be permitted to work and will not be able to bring dependants to the UK (such as your partner or children).

Visa Application Centres. In some countries the UKBA works with a local company that acts as a Visa Application Centre (VAC) and conducts visa processing. The VAC will be able to help you to collate the correct documents and will ensure that you have all the necessary details on your visa application. The VAC will then be responsible for forwarding your application the British Embassy or Consulate on your behalf.

Visa Dates. Your SVV or CVV will allow you to travel to the UK up to one week prior to your course commencement date.
